DIPLOMA IN HOSPITALITY PRACTICE (SKILLS-BASED)

The Diploma in Hospitality Practice is a skills-based programme.

A diploma level programme designed to provide students with the essential skills for their first job in the hospitality & tourism sector.

The Hospitality Practice qualification can be studied as a diploma level qualification whereby learners are enrolled in all 8 units and allows learners to focus on a specific area of hospitality such as housekeeping or front office.

The Diploma in Hospitality Practice provides students:

- with a range of essential skills they will need to perform successfully in their jobs in the hospitality & tourism industry.

Students may focus on a specific area of hospitality such as housekeeping, front office or food & beverage service.

1 Programme Structure & Core Courses

The core courses are mandatory and regularly reviewed to ensure they are up-to-date and meet industry needs as well as the latest teaching methods.

The programme is composed of 8 core courses and an internship:

- *Customer Service Skills*
- *Restaurant and Bar Service 1*
- *Restaurant and Bar Service 2*
- *Concierge and Guest Service*
- *Housekeeping 1*
- *Housekeeping 2*
- *Reception and Reservations*

2 Career Opportunities

The Diploma in Hospitality Practice will enable students to apply for jobs in hospitality and tourism organisations as reception desk professional, waiter/waitress, housekeeping, concierge, bartender and many more.



3 Admission Requirements

- A minimum age of 16 at enrollment for European students and a minimum age of 17 at enrollment for International students.
- All students without English as a first language must show competence in English at a level equal to IELTS 4.5 minimum.
- La Xenia can provide a set of placement tests where necessary to assess a student's English level
